**IN THE VINEYARD**

Situation: North-Northwest row orientation, high density vineyard blocks of 5,600 vines TO 10000 per hectare

Altitude: 200 m

Soil Type: Decomposed granite

Age of vines: 7 years

Trellising: Vertical shoot positioning

Pruning: Cordon

Irrigation: Drip

**TASTING NOTES**

The 2015 Arboretum is a blend of mostly Cabernet Sauvignon, with a roughly equal parts Merlot and Cabernet Franc with a dash of Petit Verdot. A little herbal on the nose, the fruit opens up in the glass, attaining an almost Medoc-like personality. The palate is medium-bodied with firm tannin, a little austere in style with a pinch of black pepper and clove towards the finish

Wood aging: 90% new french oak 300L barrels

Production: 3100 bottles

Alc = 13.84%; TA= 5.3g/l; RS =2.6g/l; pH= 3.68
