IN THE VINEYARD

North-Northwest row orientation, high density vineyard blocks of 5,600 vines per hectare at 200m altitude on decomposed granite

TASTING NOTES

A fresh rosé wine with complex aromas, textured strawberry and red berry on the palate with a lingering finish that works extremely well with food.

IN THE CELLAR

Whole bunch pressed the grapes (picking at 19 Brix) racked to tank after settling for a day. Fermentation took 10 days at a 15C temp. I left this wine in a tank for about 6 months on it's gross lees adding additional texture/ mouthfeel. Then bottled. I like the aromatics on this wine and the fruit.
