

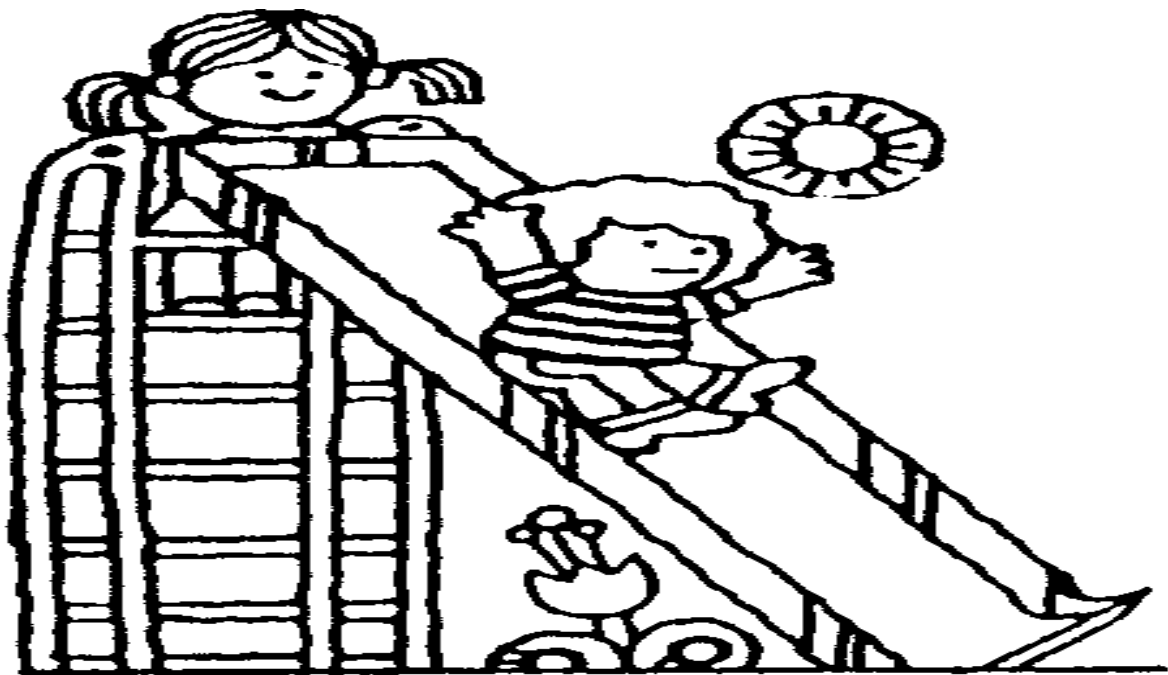

Overall objectives

- To develop children holistically (with intellectual, emotional and spiritual expansion and growth);
- Within this context, to acknowledge the important role of parents/legal guardians and therefore, to offer programmes to develop parenting skills.

Educare Center

The Educare Center is a preschool center that offers children (aged 3 to 5) a safe environment where they can learn **basic skills** in order to prepare them for the primary school level.



Our daily programme takes place from 8.00 to 15.00. Lunch is provided by the Educare Center. The children are divided into two language groups, depending on their parent's choice: **Afrikaans and English**.

The programme of the Educare Center is in line with the National Curriculum of the Department of Education. The children are taught and supervised by trained Educare teachers. In cooperation with partner organisations, New World Foundation is providing additional support to children in need, such as **counseling**.

Outings and excursions such as visits to the clinic, traffic police and fire department are part of the curriculum and are conducted on a regular basis.



All the children are tested on **school readiness**.

Evening meetings for parents are conducted on a regular basis and parents are encouraged to support their children and to take an active part in their child's development. In addition, programmes for parents are offered.

During the school holidays there is a **holiday programme**, from 9.00 till 13.00. It's more informal, the children play and have a good time.
