



Llewellyn Jordaan (Advice Office) joined the New World Foundation in 1985. He is currently a part-time staff member and responsible for the Advice Office.

Llewellyn: "This work lives within my heart and soul. To me, it's about the love and compassion for people. I have an inner drive to do this work, based on Christian principles. I try to do whatever I can to make a difference in the lives of the people from this community. But one person can never have all the answers or solutions. It's very difficult to work with human beings, especially if they are trapped in their circumstances or if they have given up on life or sunk so deep that they can't see a new tomorrow. This is especially the case when you deal with drug addiction. It's hard when people have developed that dependency, when they don't see that they have to help themselves really."

When Llewellyn is not working, he does all kinds of odd jobs as a handyman/mechanic. *Llewellyn: "It gives me satisfaction to deal with a problem on a technical level as well; at least the machines won't throw a tantrum - unless I've done a wrong analysis. It gives me pleasure to see a problem solved."*
