

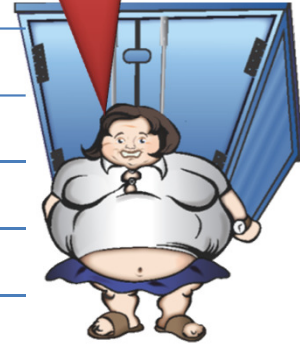

Rules:

- Participation in this competition is free subject to the following competition rules:-
- All entrants have to submit a portfolio of previous work and the attached completed entry form or an acceptable facsimile by no later than the 25th October 2011.
- Portfolios and or proposals may be e-mailed to john@fats.co.za, however, it will remain the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that the submission was received for consideration.
- Artists will be selected by FATS and their decision regarding the artists to compete will be final.
- No correspondence with regards to the decision on which artists will compete will be entered into.
- A detailed sketch / proposal of work that will be done needs to be submitted by all finalists by the 30th October 2011.
- A wall measuring approximately 24m² (8m long x 3m tall) will be allocated to selected artists.
- All selected entrants have to fulfil the following criteria:-
 - Paint the FATS Logo (size 1,8m tall x 1,4m wide). Picture to be supplied.
 - Paint the logo of the sponsor (size 1,4m wide x 1m tall). Picture to be supplied.
 - The remaining work to have a transport theme. i.e.:
 - Trucks
 - Ships
 - Aeroplanes
 - Containers
 - Maps
 - Etc.
- The decision on the winner by F.A.T.S. management will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Winner will be announced on Saturday 5th November and the prize will be handed over to the winner at a function to be advised but the date not to exceed 72 hours after completion of the duplication of the winning FATS logo.
- The winner will be required to duplicate the winning FATS logo onto the building on Sunday the 6th November 2011 for display on Monday the 7th November 2011. This artwork to be a duplicate of the winning entry and the prize money will only be handed over to the winning artist at an award ceremony, once FATS management is satisfied that the artwork is a duplicate to within reasonable and acceptable standards. No artistic freedom will be allowed with this duplication and it will have to closely resemble the winning logo.
- Competitions are subject to the privacy policy and terms and conditions of FATS (Pty) Ltd ("FATS").
- The following rules shall apply, together with any instructions or rules specific to any current competition. By entering any of our competitions, you are deemed to have accepted the following:
 - Competitions are open to all except for FATS employees and their relatives, and anyone professionally connected with the prize offered in this competition. FATS reserve the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants.
